

CLERK'S REPORT

Annual Report 2010

The Annual Meeting of the District was held on April 14, 2010. Richard H. Thorngren was elected Moderator for a one-year term.

Annual reports of the District officers were accepted as published for 2009. Bruce E. Kenerson was elected Commissioner for a term of three years and Ruth E. McMahon was elected District Clerk for the unexpired term of one year.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$ 1,081,610 for the year ending June 30, 2011, which covered the following:

Of this \$1,081,610, \$581,250, was taken from anticipated receipts, and \$500,360 was raised in the tax levy.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT JANUARY 1, 2010—DECEMBER 31, 2010

The Massachusetts Water Resources Authority supplied the District with water as follows:

Total pumped in 2010	153,500,000 gals.
Total Storage Capacity	2,065,000 gals.
Average Daily Consumption	420,000 gals.

DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

Water is distributed through pipes sized at 2" through 12" consisting of 32 miles.

The storage and delivery of water is from two above ground standpipes containing over two million gallons of water. Radio telemetry controls the pumping and storage to the system

2010 MAINTENANCE and PROJECTS

During 2010, we repaired 5 water main breaks, 1 water service break, replaced 4 iron pipe services with copper from main to meter, 2 main valves were repaired, and 3 new main valves added.

A meter replacement project started mid 2008 has resulted in the installation of over 900 new meters.

A section of the 12" water main on Walnut Street under the Rt.128/I-95 overpass was replaced and lowered by contractors doing re-construction work for roadway improvements.

Some previously proposed building projects that had been on hold have begun again. An elderly housing project behind the senior center on Salem Street, and a townhouse development off of Ramsdell Way have started.
